CULVER LAKE WOMEN'S CLUB FUNDRAISER

The Women's Club of Culver Lake is again selling Zip-Up Fleece, along with Sweatpants and Fleece Pajama Pants. The Zip-Up Fleece comes in Hunter Green with the words "Culver Lake" surrounding a forest scene, embroidered on the upper left. The Sweatpants will be available with or without pockets both with an open bottom in Navy Blue with "Culver Lake" in white printed down the leg. The Plaid Fleece pajama pants will be available in either Navy Blue/Silver or Hunter Green/White, also with the printing down the leg in white. Samples will be in the clubhouse office for you to view. Both adult and youth sizes will be available, with men and women's adult sizes available for the Hunter Green Fleece. They will be available for advance ordering only. All youth Zip-Up Fleece sizes will cost \$35 and all adult sizes will cost \$38, with the exception of the XXL, which will cost \$40.
